

# Members' Exhibition

The Members' Exhibition is a display of recent embroidery by EAC members. Any one piece may only be entered in one category. Past winners of any of the four Members' Exhibition awards may not enter the same category in the two years following their win. Youth Embroiderers who enter embroideries will receive certificates for participation.

## SEMINAR THEME AWARD

This competition is for original designs based on the seminar theme, "Island Images". Each entry must be accompanied by a statement of one page or less outlining the development of the design. This statement will be displayed with the piece. The new 'Seminar Theme' pin is awarded for this category.

## EAC ORIGINAL DESIGN AWARD

This award is based on an original embroidery with documentation to show the design process. A separate application package is available on the EAC website. The actual entry must be in the hands of the Education Director at least five days before the start of the Seminar. ## PULLED THREAD AWARD

This award is for an original Pulled Thread embroidery. A separate application package is available on the EAC website. The actual entry must be in the hands of the Education Director at least five days before the start of the Seminar. ## LEONIDA LEATHERDALE AWARD

A bone pendant is awarded by the Winnipeg Embroiderers' Guild to the member whose work is chosen by ballot as the Viewers' Choice of EAC members in attendance at the Members' Exhibition

## EXHIBITION ONLY

This category is open to teachers at Seminar 2012 and to any EAC member who would like to display their work.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES for EAC MEMBERS' EXHIBITION

- Entry Form deadline is Monday, April 16, 2012
- Late registration will not be accepted.
- A colour photograph must accompany the Exhibition Entry Form, and include the title of the piece and the embroiderer's name.

- The piece must be appropriately equipped for hanging or display. The Exhibition Committee is not able to supply display equipment.
- Marks identifying the stitcher will be covered until voting has been completed.
- It is recommended that embroideries with glass be hand delivered.
- All pieces must be received before noon on Tuesday May 15, 2012. Receipts for entries will be issued. These are required when claiming pieces after the close of the Members' Exhibition.

## GENERAL CRITERIA for ALL ENTRIES

Only EAC members are eligible to exhibit embroideries. It is not a requirement to attend Seminar to be an exhibitor. Each entry must be worked with a threaded needle, have been completed in the last two years, and must not have been shown at a previous Seminar. The member entering the embroidery must have stitched the work entered. Any member may have their work displayed in the Exhibition Only Category. Teachers who are teaching at Seminar 2012 are not allowed to enter embroideries in the Leonida Leatherdale Award or Seminar Theme award competitions. They may enter the Exhibition Only category.

## SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

Shipped entries must arrive in a reusable box with return postage and insurance included. Include a self addressed return label. Please have your identification on all packing materials. You will be advised via e-mail or your self-addressed postcard when your piece arrives. The Seminar committee is not responsible for loss or damage.
