The different stitches we use are: Pistol stitch, strait stitch, herringbone stitch, whipped/laced running stitch, back stitch, fly stitch, french knot stitch, running stitch and detached chain stitch. Oma sewed it up for me and I stuffed it. It was a great way to use some of my extra time.
