

## Ornament or Coaster

This is stitched on a piece of material called Waffle Pique (pronounced Peakay). This cloth has a large count, and you weave your threads under the threads in the material as opposed to stitching through them.

I made an ornament and a coaster. The diagram below on the left side shows the stitching I used for the ornament. I used just 3 different colours of thread and wove them in and out. Then I folded in the corners and sewed it up in the back (the back is pretty too). I added a tassel and hanging string and put a charm in the centre of the ornament (See the Try A New Stitch at [www.eac.ca](http://www.eac.ca) under the Youth section for instructions to make a tassel)

The diagram below on the right side shows the weaving pattern I used for the coaster. Then I fringed the edges and voila!
