

Service Pin Policy

The Board of Directors of the Embroiderers' Association of Canada, Inc is pleased to announce the introduction of a new Service Pin to honour the individuals who have significantly contributed to the organization. The EAC Service Pin is presented in recognition of the members who have demonstrated active participation, service and dedication to EAC, who embody all that we are as a community.

Criteria

To be considered for the EAC Service Pin an individual must:

- Be an active EAC member
- Have contributed on a local, regional or national level to bring recognition to the Association

The following criteria will be considered in reviewing nominations for this award.

Nominees will excel in one or more of the following areas:

- Special and notable service to EAC, such as participation in special projects
- Participation in EAC educational programs and/or public speaking activities
- Mentoring activities which encourage others in the pursuit of the art of embroidery
- Long-time (*20+ years*) membership with active participation on a local level
- Author/publish needlework-related articles of particular significance to EAC

The above list is not intended to be an exhaustive list of criteria. Individuals whose contributions to the Association take other forms may also be nominated.

Nominations must include

- A letter of nomination, including the candidate's full name and address
- A narrative supporting the nomination, to include a discussion of the candidate's contribution to EAC
- The name, e-mail address and phone number of the nominating party.

Submission Procedure

Nominations may be submitted by any EAC member.

Nominations to be submitted in writing to the EAC Vice President.

Presentation of the Pin will be made at the discretion of the Board.

Deadline: All nominations must be received by March 31st.
